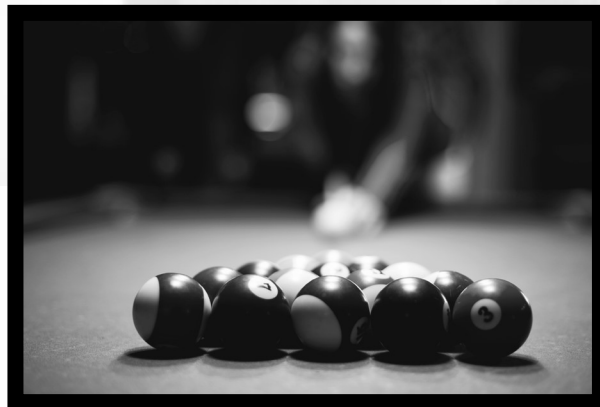

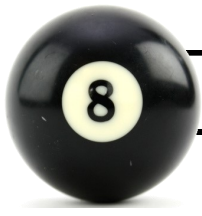

All entrants restricted to participating in one (1) Singles and one (1) Team Event.

Event Format

All events are double elimination. Brackets for all events will play to completion; there will be no redraws. Played on 90 Pool Tables. Level A is a higher level than that of B.

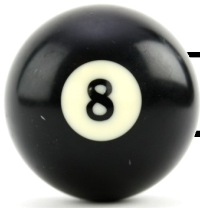

The Tournament Committee has the right to expediate play by playing on 3-5 tables to ensure timely completion of events.



POOL PLAYER ELIGIBILITY & CLASSIFICATION

Age & Sanction Requirement

- A. Entrants must be at least 21 years of age unless participating in the Junior Team event.
- B. Junior players must be 9-20 years of age.
- C. All players must be sanctioned by the VNEA and the IAMOA to participate in the tournament.

League Requirement

- 1. Games must be played between March 1, 2019 and February 17, 2020
- 2. League nights consist of majority of games played per night. **Maximum of 2 league nights per calendar day.**
- 3. All games must be played in leagues run by and on equipment owned by the IAMOA operator.
- 4. All team members must meet league requirements through the same operator.

Singles	Player must have at least 12 league nights and 36 games.
Open Team	Four (4) players must have at least 12 league nights and 36 games; 1 player with 8 league nights and 24 games. Must have 2 original players from the same team.
Ladies Team	Three (3) players must have at least 12 league nights and 36 games; 1 player with 8 league nights and 24 games. Must have 2 original players from the same team.
Masters Team	Four (4) players must have at least 12 league nights and 36 games; 1 player with 8 league nights and 24 games. No requirement for number of original players.

Classification

- 1. Only one A Division Player can be on a roster on a B Division Team
- 2. No Master Division Player can be on a roster on a B Division Team
- 3. Only one Master Division Player can play on an A Division Team

Singles

Men's B Division	Top 32 Players to A Division
Men's A Division	Top 16 players to Masters Division
Ladies Singles	Top 8 players to Masters

Teams

Men's B Division	Top 8 teams to A Division
Men's A Division	Top 4 teams to Masters Division
Ladies Division	Top 4 teams to Ladies Masters Division

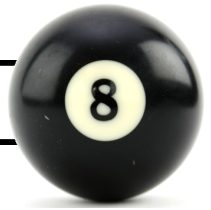

Master and A Players must participate in the tournament in their respective division for the total number of years listed to qualify for removal from the list:

Master Players: 2 years
A Players: 5 years*

**All Ladies Masters are on the A List, but are eligible to be removed from the A list after two years of participation.*

POOL PLAYER ELIGIBILITY & CLASSIFICATION



Out-of-State Player Classification

Out of state players that are on a high level player list in another state due to performance at a state or other tournament will be classified as follows:

Tournament	Designated as:	Must play at or above division:
Ohio State Tournament	AA Players	A Division
Michigan State Tournament	Masters and Intermediate	A Division
Illinois ACS Tournament	Masters	A Division
Indiana ACS Tournament	Masters	A Division

League performance should be taken into consideration and Operators should put players in the a higher level regardless of this classification if the player is a Master level player.
